SUBJECT: Monumental, Digital Mural at LAX depicts vast Los Angeles skyline

Los Angeles World Airports and The Los Angeles Department of Cultural Affairs presents artist Susan Logoreci's *Los Angeles - The Dream Décor of Oblivion* a large scale digital mural created from three 4 x 6 foot, colored pencil drawings of aerial views of the Los Angeles skyline.

Each drawing was photographed and digitally blown up many times larger than their original size and slightly replicated to create a panoramic view of Los Angeles that is at once wondrous and overwhelming, confusing and stunning.

The piece consists of two 30 foot long, 10 foot high panels that will greet visitors as they arrive in Los Angeles in the Terminal 1 (Southwest/US Air) baggage claim area from Mid May through October at LAX .

About the artist: Susan Logoreci was born in Monterey, CA. She earned a BFA from the San Francisco Art Institute and an MFA from California State University Long Beach. Her work has been featured in Art in America, Harper's Magazine and Mcsweeney's Quarterly Concern. Her drawings have been collected by Creative Artist's Agency, City National Bank and the U.S. State Department among others. She has exhibited in the United States and abroad.
